Home Chore

"Your connection to helping hands"

This service matches Case Management clients who need basic household chores help with individual volunteers/volunteer groups who provide assistance and friendly visitation.

Food Bridge

"Your connection to wholesome groceries"
This service offers monthly food pantry delivery for Case Management clients at nutritional risk throughout Madison and Monona. This service is a collaboration between NewBridge Madison, the River Food Pantry, and RSVP of Dane County.

MONTHLY MIPPA MOMENT: PREVENTING PNEUMONIA

MIPPA (Medicare Improvements for Patients and Providers Act) has a goal of educating older adults on Medicare's cost-saving benefits & preventive services.

Did you know that about 1 million Americans go to the hospital with pneumonia each year? Pneumonia is a lung infection caused by pneumococcal disease, which can also cause blood infections and meningitis. The bacteria that causes pneumococcal disease spreads through person-to-person contact. There's a vaccine to help prevent pneumonia, but only 67% of adults 65 and over have ever gotten it.

Medicare can help protect you from pneumococcal infections by getting the pneumococcal shot. Medicare Part B covers the shot and a second shot one year after you got the first shot. You may be at a higher risk if you:

- Are 65 or older
- Have a chronic illness (like asthma, diabetes, or lung, heart, liver, or kidney disease)
- Have a condition that weakens your immune system (like HIV, AIDS, or cancer)
- Live in a nursing home or other facility
- Have cochlear implants or cerebrospinal fluid (CSF) leaks
- Smoke tobacco

Protect yourself from pneumonia—get your pneumococcal shot today.



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


